



Open Broadband Footprint March 2019




Open Broadband Deployment Model - Hybrid




2) Public Private Partnerships

Other County/Town Partnerships

Gaston Co: Providing service to City of Belmont, downtown Wi-Fi zone, and TechWorks innovation center. Working with Bessemer City, Cherryville, Cramerton, county library system.

Wayne Co: Providing service in various parts of the county, including Fremont, Goldsboro, Mt. Olive, Seven Springs, and Grantham. Wi-Fi zones, MO Airport, University of Mt Olive.


NW Duplin Co: Offering service to residents of Calypso and Faison, and the northwest portion of the county.



3) GREAT Broadband Grants 2019

- \$10M for Tier 1 counties only
- Grant can only be used for census blocks that don't have 10x1 speed
- Up to \$2M awarded per County
- Only one award per County

- Total counties where applications were submitted: 19
- Open Broadband applied for 3



4) USDA ReConnect Grants 2019

What is it? Federal financing and funding options in the form of loans, grants, and loan/grant combinations to facilitate broadband deployment in areas of rural America that don't currently have sufficient access to broadband. \$600M program.

- 1. Rural Broadband Grant, with applicant supplying a cash contribution equal to 25% of project cost.
- 2. Grant + Loan Combo (50% of award as a grant/50% of award as a loan at Treasury rate of approximately 3.875%)
- 3. Low Interest Rural Broadband Loan (fixed at 2%)

Applications open April 23 - May 31
